I imagine that, especially against somewhat weak competition that folds too often, you should actually 3bet most of your marginal hands and call with your premium hands, forcing your opponents to fold when you have junk and stay in the pot when you have the effective nuts.

You should avoid calling unless you have a good reason like trapping an opponent. Rules on the movement of the blinds and dealer button when the big blind or little blind leaves the game goes broke could be clearer. By 3-betting opening raises with strong hands, you will extract more value from your opponents by increasing the size of the pot early in the hand.
